



2018 Expectations for Members of the HCTA Board of Directors

- 1. Regularly attend meetings of the Board of Directors and Representative Council as well as other meetings and functions regarded as essential to perform the duties of a Director. (Examples: Leadership Training, Legislative Training, and Political Receptions.) Meetings are normally held in the evenings and on weekends.**
- 2. Actively promote and support HCTA as an organization and promote and support the positions adopted by the Representative Council.**
- 3. Actively promote membership in HCTA.**
- 4. Serve on HCTA, District and State Committees (DOE and FEA), as requested by the HCTA President.**
- 5. Support and assist elected Association Representatives.**
- 6. Support and promote all programs sponsored by the Association for the benefit of the membership. (Examples: ER&D, all Representative Trainings, New Teacher Orientation, Teacher Interview Day and Member Benefits for Enrollment opportunities.)**
- 7. Support and actively work for HCTA-PAC endorsed candidates for political office.**
- 8. Directors should be open to opinions and ideas that differ from one's personal views that may best serve the Association.**
