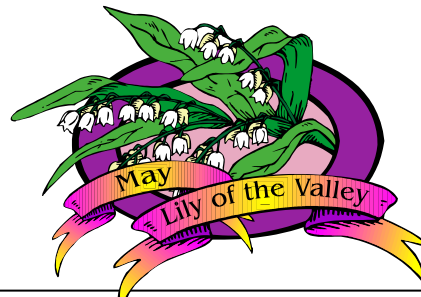
Please Note: Due to the Pandemic we have suspended meetings until further notice. We hope you are all staying safe out there.
