On April 21 we heard from UF history professor **Paul Ortiz**, a third-generation veteran, a leader in FEA's United Faculty of Florida, and author of **Emancipation Betrayed, the Hidden History of Black Organizing in Florida**. He spoke about the 1920 Ocoee Election Day Massacre, the leaders in the Black community, and events leading up to that day. He answered questions about voting rights, personal histories, and current events.

On March 17 we enjoyed a tour of **USF Botanical Gardens** led by director Laurie Walker. We didn't cover all 16 acres and 3,000 plants but did see cycads, cactus and succulents, bamboo, grasses, wetlands, pollinators, and orchids. The gardens and gift shop are open Tuesday to Saturday 9-3 pm.
